Assoc. Prof. Dr. Charun Bunyakan

Vice-President for Academic Affairs, Walailak University

Assoc. Professor Dr. Charun Bunyakan is a Vice President for Academic Affairs of Walailak University. Since the commencement of this leadership role 2016, his work had been predicated on overseeing management of all the schools through maintaining and enhancing quality education by leading, advising and cooperating with Deans and Heads of Program to ensure quality admission, standard teaching and learning management, student care and production of qualified graduates.

Before assuming an executive position at Walialak university, Assoc. He taught both undergraduate (Bachelor degree) and postgraduate (Master degree and Ph.D.) students and got promoted to as assistant professor and an associate professor respectively over the course of five years

Regarding his role in an executive position, Assoc. Professor Dr. Charun's leadership commenced with responsibilities as Deputy Head of Department of Chemical Engineering in 1999 and Head of Department of the Department of Chemical engineering within the Faculty of Engineering at the PSU of which he was became an Associate Dean for Research and Graduate Studies. His eight years in this position had been predicated on restructuring of research operations to benefit both faculty members and post-graduate students. Finally, as Dean of the faculty in 2011, Assoc. Professor Dr. Charun's key responsibility involved supervision of academic affairs including student support schemes of undergraduate and postgraduate levels, setting up facilities and creating research environments to support staff teaching and research.
